After clicking the patient portal link, the Portal log in screen should appear as below.



Email/Password

In the email address field you will enter your personal email address. If you already have an account set up with us, you may use your current password to enter the dashboard. If you have visited our patient portal before and are unsure of your password you may used the forgot password link. This will send you an email to securely reset your password.

If you are new to our patient dashboard you will receive a Welcome Email containing the temporary password which you can copy and paste into the password field.

All passwords will display as dots (••••••) when you type them for added security. Once your email and password have been entered, click the **LOGIN** button.

If you are new to our patient dashboard and received the welcome letter after entering the temporary password you will be asked to verify your date of birth.

Password Requirements:

- Password must be 5 characters long
- Passwords must have an upper and lower case
- Passwords must include a number
- Passwords must include a symbol
